NEA Rhode Island Children's Fund**

In 1985, the National Education Association Rhode Island recognized that many students in our schools indeed were struggling. They lived without basic necessities of food, clothing and shelter despite the availability of social assistance programs. NEA Rhode Island established the Children's Fund to fulfill modest and immediate needs of the students encountered by NEA Rhode Island members in their daily workplace.

Supported by donations, the fund makes money available to NEARI members who might otherwise reach into their own pockets to buy a warm coat or a new pair of shoes. In some cases, the Fund has supplemented other sources of assistance, or cooperated with merchants and physicians to help a child with a more complex problem. The Fund works to ensure that the physical, social and emotional needs of students do not stand in the way of success within the school setting.

How to access the Children's Fund.....

There is never any red tape or lengthy delay for members accessing the Fund. A simple call to NEARI headquarters is usually all that is needed. All requests are handled discreetly and in confidence, so the recipients are not embarrassed by the donations. Often it's the member involved who actually delivers the clothing or other services needed. In that way, the personal nature of the Fund's operation sets it apart from most traditional sources of financial assistance.
